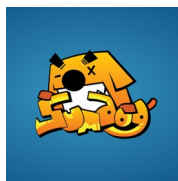

Summer Reading Challenge

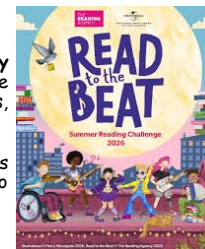
