### COVID-19 UPDATE

The information below is provided for parents by The Department for Education.

#### CONTACT TRACING AND ISOLATION

Nursery, school or college will no longer trace close contacts - close contacts will be identified via NHS Test and Trace. NHS Test and Trace will work with the positive case and/or their parents to identify close contacts. As parents or carers, you may be contacted to help with identifying close contacts.

Individuals are not required to self-isolate if they live in the same household as someone with COVID-19, or are a close contact of someone with COVID-19, and any of the following apply:

- they are fully vaccinated
- they are below the age of 18 years and 6 months

• they have taken part in or are currently part of an approved COVID-19 vaccine trial

• they are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons

Instead, NHS Test and Trace will inform affected individuals, children or their parents or carers that they have been in close contact with a positive case, and advise them to take a PCR test. We would encourage all individuals to take a PCR test if advised to do so.

If there is a substantial increase in the number of positive cases in nursery, school, or college, or if your nursery, school, or college is in an enhanced response area, you might be advised that some control measures need to be temporarily reintroduced.

### POSITIVE RAPID LATERAL FLOW TEST RESULTS

Anyone with a positive test result will need to:

- self-isolate in line with the stay at home guidance
- book a further test (a lab-based polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test) to confirm the result

Whilst awaiting the PCR result, the individual should continue to self-isolate.

If the PCR test is taken within the 2 days following the positive LFD result, and is negative, it overrides the self-test LFD test and your child can return to nursery, childminders, school or college, as long as they don't have COVID-19 symptoms.

# IF YOU SUSPECT YOUR CHILD HAS CORONAVIRUS OR HAS A POSITIVE TEST

Do not send your child to their nursery, childminder, school, college or to an entry test for a selective school if:

they are showing one or more coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms

• they have had a positive test result

• there are other reasons requiring them to stay at home, for example, they are required to quarantine

Schools are no longer required to inform parents and carers when there is a positive case. This may change if there are a number of cases in the school or temporary local control measures require it. <u>Year R 2021</u>
