Well done to Year 3 who shared their NSPCC themed class assembly this week. The children shared the importance of 'speaking out and staying safe'.



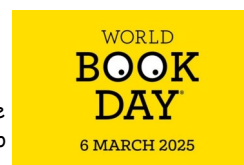
## Book Week
