



The Mission Rosary is made up of five different colours, each representing a different continent: Africa (green), Americas (red), Europe (white), Oceania (blue), Asia (Yellow).

How to pray the Rosary

- 1 Hold the Crucifix and make the Sign of the Cross.
- 2 Hold the first bead and say the Our Father.
- 3 On the next three beads say one Hail Mary.
- 4 On the fifth bead say the Glory Be. Keep hold of this bead and begin the first decade of the rosary with the Our Father.
- 5 On each of the ten beads now say a Hail Mary.
- 6 On the bead before the next decade say the Glory Be and Our Father.

This is a Mission Rosary. The coloured beads help us to pray for our sisters and brothers around the world.

The rosary is a special set of beads that Catholics use to help them pray.
