Year 3 Class of the Week

This week, year 3 have thoroughly enjoyed reading our class text - When the Mountains Roared and have been planning and drafting their own setting descriptions from beautiful beaches to castles in the sky. Maths this week has focussed on time where the children have been using prior knowledge to solve various problems and have loved being out in the sunshine becoming human clocks competeing in teams to display the correct time. In Science, the children are exploring the human skeletal and muscular systems and have alrady identified areas of study that will help solve this terms enquiry question - Does height impact the distance you jump?



In Geography, the children have been exploring predators and in the coming weeks will be creating some fantastic fact files about some of the worlds apex predators highlighting why they are top of their food chain and how their environment and habitat help with this. Our RE focus is reconciliation and how it is a big part of our day to day lives. Some children, in preparation for thier holy communion have celebrated their first sacrament of reconciliation which was fascinating to hear about. Also in RE, we have celebrated St George's Day where the children have explored the origins of St George and uncovered some pretty big misconceptions.
