### Sports Day

If you wish; your child may wear the colour of their house on their t-shirt (this does not need to be a block colour) - or they may wear their PE t-shirt. In class, the children will be making rosettes to represent their 'House' colour. (Please do not feel you need to buy a new t- shirt). All children should still wear their plain navy PE shorts (not cycling shorts) or tracksuit bottoms (not leggings).

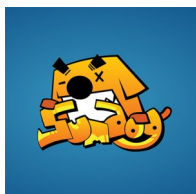
