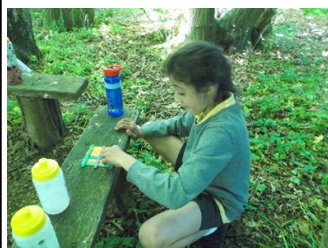

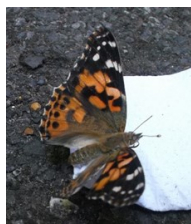

We released our butterflies today. We watched them grow from tiny caterpillars and change into their cocoons.

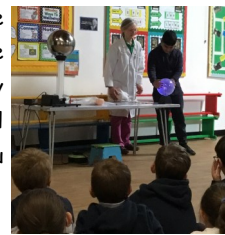


Mini-Youth Cricket
